

General Visitor Regulations of the National Museum of Lithuania

Tickets

Please keep your ticket with you for the duration of your visit.

Children

Please do not leave children unattended.

Exhibition

Touching the Museum exhibits is prohibited.

Running, loud and improper behaviour, or causing disturbance to other visitors to the Museum is prohibited.

Cloakroom and lockers

Coats, bags, umbrellas and other personal items must be left in the cloakroom or lockers.

Please take your valuables with you. The Museum does not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to the left items.

Please do not leave any items unattended, as they may be removed by the Museum staff.

Photography

It is permitted to photograph and film free of charge for personal use. However, the use of a camera stand or flash is prohibited.

Food and beverages

Visitors may not bring food or beverages into the Museum's exhibition spaces.

It is prohibited to either bring or consume alcohol, narcotic or intoxicating substances in the entire Museum territory. Individuals who appear intoxicated from alcohol, narcotic or other intoxicating substances shall not be allowed into the Museum.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in the entire Museum territory, including the central courtyard.

Animals

No animals may be brought into the Museum territory.

Bicycles

Visitors with roller skates, roller blades, scooters, bicycles and skateboards are not admitted into the Museum territory.

Other

It is prohibited to bring weapons, knives and other dangerous items into the Museum territory.

Enforcement

The Museum staff has the right to escort the visitors who are acting in violation of the Museum Visitor Regulations from the Museum.
